EVERY MAN A MIRACLE WORKER !

Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. 1 John 4:17 NKJV

The conflict at the end of the age will not be over theology, but rather power. It will not be concerning whose book do you read, but rather whose God answers by fire. The Lord is raising up His army all over the world and filling them with the power of the Holy Spirit. He became sin for us in His death on the Cross, but every sin was canceled, with its effects permanently and unalterably blotted out, with His resurrection. With His ascension, every hold of this world was eliminated, with Him even overruling all the laws of physics, gravity and propulsion.

Now, the same miracle working power and authority that is in Him, is in us!

As He IS, so ARE we in this world! As He is the only begotten Son of God, so are we sons and daughters of the most high God. As He is heir to the throne of God, so are we joint heirs in Him! As He is righteous, so have we been made the righteousness of God in Him. As He is the Victor over this world, so are we victors in Him.
